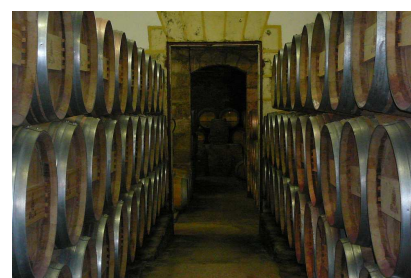
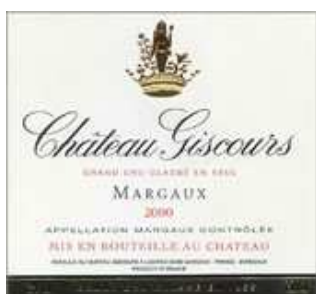


Discover the magic of the Bordeaux vineyards.

At 08.00 departure from Biarritz by bus direction Bordeaux, you will take the motorway crossing the department of “**Les Landes**”. More than 93 % of the land in “Les Landes” is used for agricultural purposes (244 000 ha) or is forested (632 000 ha) and 60 % of the Gascogne forest (the largest forest in Europe) is located in “Les Landes”.



Our first destination is the appellation **Margaux** with the Château Giscours – Grand Cru Classé 1855. You will visit the wine cellar followed by a tasting of two wines, **Château Duthil** and **Château Giscours**.



After this visit you will go to Pauillac following the famous “**Wine road**”. In Pauillac you will have lunch in the harvest room of the **Château Lynch Bages**. The lunch will be accompanied by the following wines: as a welcome drink Michel Lynch white further there will be **Château Villa Bel Air – Graves**, **Château Haut Bages Averous 2002** (2nd wine of the Cht Lynch Bages) and **Château Lynch Bages 1998**. During the lunch the wines will be commented by our sommelier.



After lunch you will have a guided visit at the Château Lynch Bages and a tasting of 2 wines, **Château Haut Bages Averous 2001** and **Château Lynch Bages 2001**.

Inscription has to be done **before March 31** at **Bordeaux Saveurs**.

Each inscription has to be accompanied by a payment by credit card.

The rate per person is **150 €** and includes the **transportation**, the **2 visits** and **tasting**, **lunch** and the **wines**. A minimum of 45 people per bus (maximum 2 busses) is requested.

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
